

SACRAMENTAL LITURGIES: BAPTISM

The Baptism proper takes place after the parents and godparents have renounced sin and professed their faith in the name of the child. Baptism means literally a "dipping," because they were immersed into waters, such as the scene at Our Lord's baptism. It was the standard practice of the early church. Those to be baptized were led to separate rooms where they stripped and the men were baptized by a deacon and the women by a deaconess. It was only later that the practice of pouring water became more common. Still the practice of immersion is the preferred method according to the liturgical documents. It is best understood as a bath in which the child is completely cleansed and welcomed into the community. Anyone who prefers this method of baptism for their children may request it.
