

Grades 7 & 8 Art Supply List – Kindly bring in the first day of school 2018-2019

*Any supplies used last year can be used again this year. If your child ran out of only charcoal, for example, just purchase a pack of charcoal rather than the whole “assortment.” Everyone should have a small pencil box labeled. The Watercolors and Oil Pastels can be labeled separately and kept in their respective boxes/cases so they can be stacked on the shelf, saving space.

Label the following:

- __ 18x24” Newsprint Pad, 50 Sheets (\$6.17 at Blick vs. 13.99 at Michael’s)
- __ sketchbook (any size, can be partially used already, between 7x10” and 9x12”)
- __ Crayola Washable Watercolors, Set of 16 Colors
- __ Sakura Cray-Pas Junior Artist Oil Pastels, Set of 25 (\$2.69 at Blick) (or whatever brand you already have)
- __ One Dry Floral Foam Brick, green, about 3 x 3.5 x 8” (Michael’s/Hobby Lobby)
- __ 5x8” pencil box LABELED (larger boxes may be returned for lack of space), to hold the following:
- __ General’s Charcoal Drawing Assortment - contains 2 charcoal pencils, 3 compressed charcoal sticks, 4 willow charcoal sticks, kneaded eraser, sharpener (\$8.78 at Blick) (or just willow/vine & compressed charcoal)

* I recommend not waiting too long to get the supplies and venturing to Blick (across from Adler’s on Wickenden St – there’s a small parking lot) or ordering online from them. If you purchased the coupon book from last year’s fundraiser, there’s a coupon in there!
