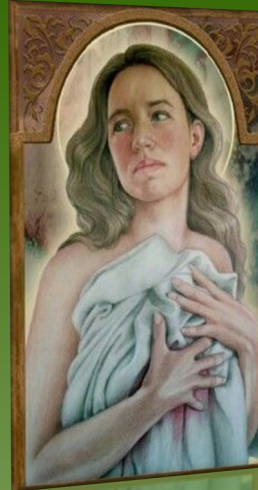

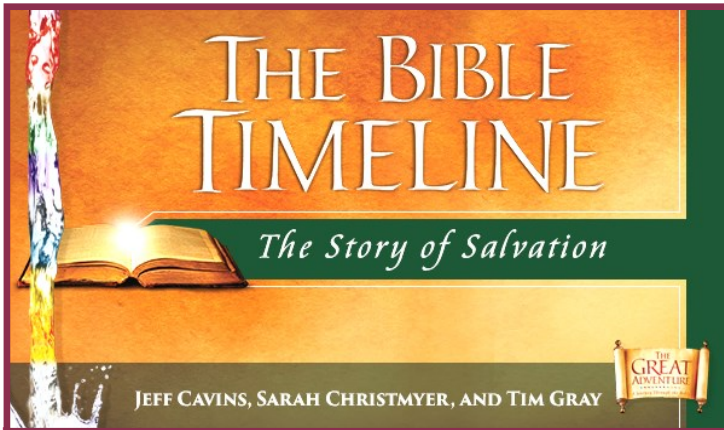
Assurance Statement of compliance with the purposes of Title IX Education Act
