Who cares for the toddler whose only home is the backseat of a car? Who gives his parents hope with a bag of food and gift card so that their father can search for work? Who offers hope to the homeless man who lives in an alley with all his belongings in a backpack and plastic bag? Who reaches out to allow young foster children a summer camp experience, providing supplies to school aged children, and diapers for a young single mother just trying to make ends meet?

This past year your generosity has helped care for over 750 people in our community that required a level of help through the Society of St. Vincent De Paul, St. Julie's Conference.

The food pantry was visited over 531 times and gave 2,650 bags of food to our clients. This service provides much-needed nutrition to families and individuals.

Many client cases and food pantry visits involve small children. We have been stocking diapers and other essentials for the little ones. Several families faced eviction, and many close to having utilities or water shut-off.
