Question: Why do we have a credit card fee and use a credit card if we are in debt?

Answer: The parishes no longer have a credit card. All bills are paid in full on time. When a bill comes in it is placed in Fr. Dan's mailbox for him to initial for payment. Once this is done it is placed in the accountant's mailbox and paid that week (usually on Thursday). The credit card fee is a fee assessed for those parishioners who pay their stewardship through our on line giving program. This type of giving allows parishioners to give to the parish on a regular basis even if they are away on vacation or home sick.

Be Merciful Like the Father

Celebrating the Jubilee Year of Mercy

In his 2015 Lenten message, Pope Francis encourages us to ask the Lord to make our hearts like His. In this way, we will receive a heart which is firm and merciful, attentive and generous; a heart which is not closed, indifferent, or prey to the globalization of indifference.”

Today’s gospel is all about conversion. If we are living with both feet firmly on the earth, we cannot but see that we live in a world that is not exactly God’s world. We are not always the people we are called to be, many situations and structures need change and many people live in misery. We need conversion and the world around us needs conversion. In today’s first reading from Exodus, the Lord is quoted as saying “I have witnessed the affliction of my people in Egypt...” As we follow the rest of the Exodus event, we know that God sent Moses to lead the Israelites to a new freedom from slavery. Do we see the sufferings of our brothers and sisters and what do we do about it? For conversion means changing our ways, turning back to God and to one another.

In the parable of the fig tree, Jesus reminds us that our challenge (especially during Lent) is to allow Jesus to “cultivate” us and to “fertilize” us so that we recognize the areas in our lives that need repentance (change) and can begin bearing even more fruit.

In this special time of grace and mercy, we are encouraged to reflect more deeply on the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. The corporal works of mercy call us to feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, clothe the naked, welcome the stranger, heal the sick, visit the imprisoned, and bury the dead.

The spiritual works of mercy beckon us to counsel the doubtful, instruct the ignorant, admonish sinners, comfort the afflicted, forgive offenses, bear wrongs patiently, and pray for the living and the dead. Are we willing to change? As we continue our journey together this Lent, let us allow the embrace of God’s mercy to continue transforming our hearts, making them more and more like His own heart of mercy and love.

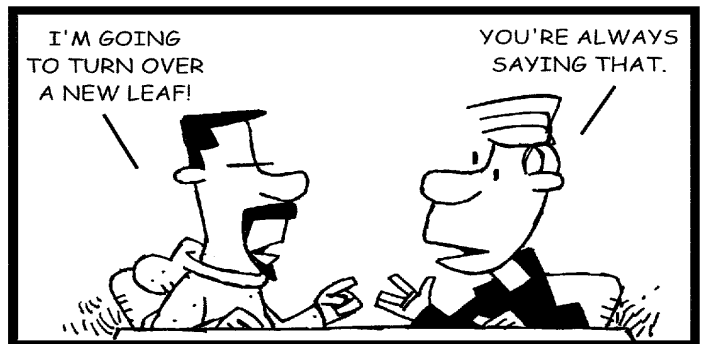

Have you thought of a vocation to the priesthood? Come and learn more. The Diocese of Worcester's annual discernment retreat, directed by

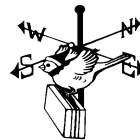
Bishop McManus, will be held on

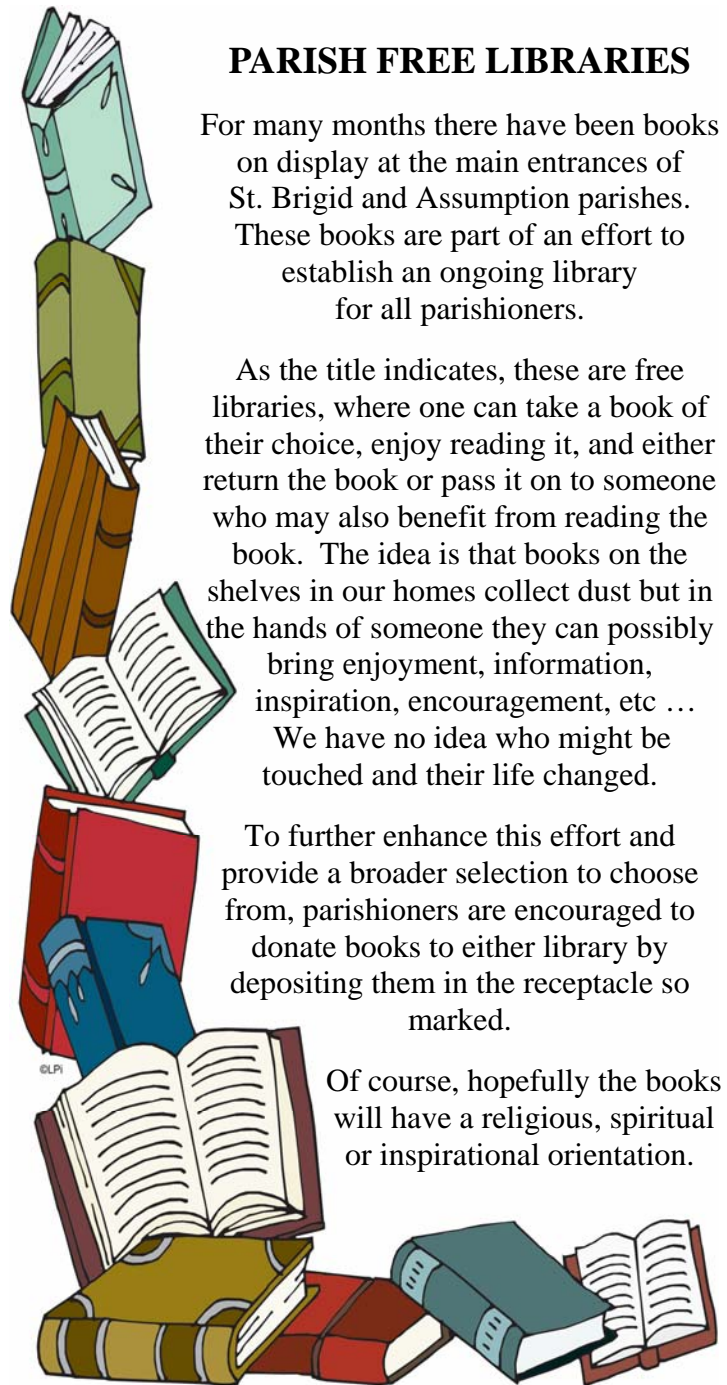
PARISH FREE LIBRARIES
