Pastor's Letter

Dear Parish Family,

Last weekend, our Finance Council Members, headed by Chuck DeMeola, gave us a summary financial report of the Fiscal Years 2015 and 2016. As you all can see in the report, our revenues for Sundays and Holydays from 2015 to 2016 have dwindled significantly – a difference of \$65,649 from last year to this year. Our expenditures have come down a bit this year, which is a good thing. But, looking ahead, if we are unable to raise our revenues for Sundays and Holydays significantly and cut down our expenditures, I do not know how we will be able to survive in the future. Right now, we are trying to raise funds through the 50/50 Raffle and the St. Andrew's Memorial Tree. I ask you, therefore, to support us in these endeavors

This year, we embarked on two major projects – the installation of a new sound system and the replacement of the Church roof. I am told that many are quite happy with our new sound system, although we are still working out some of the kinks. The replacement of the Church roof has presented some challenges. The Diocese and our parish committee have been constantly monitoring the progress of this project.

I recently learned that the rectory's 22 year old boiler needs to be replaced at a cost of \$8,000. Another headache is the "cooling tower" outside the Church which needs major repair or replacement. At this time, this repair is not in our current budget. The good news is the repair of the cooling system can wait till spring. As you know, the retaining wall of the church facing the parking lot needs to be repaired as well. This has been a concern we have had for a few years.

I am sharing this information to make you aware of what we are going through at this time. I know most of you have been very supportive and generous in helping our parish. I appreciate and thank you. Unfortunately, we are aware of a number of our registered parishioners who are not making any contributions. I would like to appeal to them most earnestly. If you are able to increase your weekly contribution by a few dollars, it would be greatly appreciated. As always, I thank you for your support and sacrificial help.

Our parish is our home. We need to take care of it. Every one of us who love our parish should help take care of our home.

May you all have a wonderful Thanksgiving!
