Note from Pastor:

Deacon Garry LeBlanc and his wife Melinda and I will be travelling to Rome tomorrow (Monday, September 24) to attend the deacon ordination of Joseph Sigur. Joseph is from Port Arthur and is a 2011 graduate of Monsignor Kelly Catholic High School in Beaumont. He has been in the seminary since 2011, and the last 4 years he has been studying at the North American College in Rome, the seminary for Americans in Rome. After his deacon ordination next week, Joseph will complete his final year of preparation for the priesthood and his ordination as a priest is scheduled for June at St. Anthony Cathedral in Beaumont. He will be ordained a priest together with Anthony McFarland who is completing his priestly studies this year at the seminary in Houston. I am excited to visit Rome again. The LeBlanc's and I will spend a week and a half attending the ordination at St. Peter's Basilica, and assisting at Joseph's first Mass as a deacon the next day at historic St. Clement Church in Rome. We will also have a chance to see some of the sights in and around Rome. Bishop Guillory and several other local priests and many of Joseph's family and friends will be there as well. I am also very excited that we will ordain two faithful young men as priests for our diocese next year. We need good and holy priests now more than ever. Please keep us in your prayers as we travel, and please continue to pray for good priestly vocations around the world, and especially in our Diocese of Beaumont.
