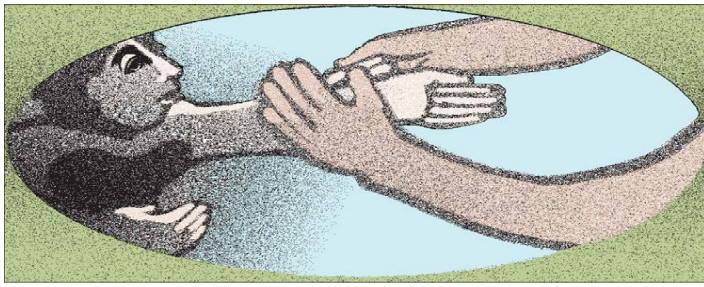

**Note from Pastor:**

This week on Thursday the names of clergy who have had credible and substantiated claims of abuse of minors against them since 1950 were released by the Bishops of all the dioceses Texas. This includes our own Diocese of Beaumont, dating back to 1966 when the diocese was founded. Names of clergy with credible abuse claims who worked in this area between 1950-1966 would be included on the list released by the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston. As I write this note on Tuesday, I do not yet have access to the names. The action this week is a response of the bishops to the demands of transparency and justice.

I join Bishop Guillory in calling for our continued prayers for any child who has been victimized by an adult, including victims of clergy. As pastor at St. Mark's and Infant Jesus I take seriously the obligation to make our parish communities as safe as possible for all people, especially our children.

Over the last 18 years, since the establishment of a nationwide program for Catholic parishes, we have trained tens of thousands of adults who work with children in our parishes and schools. The bishops have also set up independent review boards in each diocese to investigate claims of sexual abuse against children, and they approved a policy to immediately remove any adult, clergy or layperson, from ministry if the claim of abused is judged by the independent board to be "substantiated". In addition, any reporting of abuse must always first be made to the police, and then the diocese.

These measures, known collectively as the Dallas Charter, are working well. That's true nationally, as well as locally, as Bishop Guillory's letter this weekend makes clear. I want to thank all those in our parish who help maintain our compliance with these norms. Our compliance is audited locally every year, and by a national group on a regular basis as well.

We put considerable resources of time and finances into thorough background checks, training of volunteers in the "Protecting God's Children" program, and in programs to educate our youth in a Gospel way about their dignity and right to protection from predatory behavior. I am grateful to all who help us keep focused on this vital obligation that we have.

I encourage you to read the Bishop's statement on the Diocesan website and to continue to join in prayer and the good works that we have begun to keep our children safe.
