

### COMMUNICATION OFFICE

**Microsoft Office 2007:** The Diocese upgraded to Office 2007 just prior to Christmas. We will continue sending documents to parishes in the old “.doc format” until the 1<sup>st</sup> of July 2009. After that we will start emailing documents in the new “.docx format”. We are not requiring parishes to purchase or upgrade to Office 2007 by July 1, but have the ability to open Office 2007 documents.

If you are using Office 2000, Office XP, or Office 2003 software, there is a free compatibility patch that will allow you to open the new format (Office 2007 files). If you have an older version, like Office 1997, then you must upgrade to one of these supported versions. The free patch can be downloaded from this website:

On your behalf, the Diocese can order an Office 2007 Professional Plus license for \$65 (plus tax and handling) **per computer**. This package has Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Publisher and Outlook included. **Word 2007 Hands-On Training:** Office 2007 has a different look than previous versions. The toolbars are now called ribbons. To familiarize you with this new look and navigation we are providing hands-on training for Word 2007. This is an overview of “this is how you do it”. It will answer the questions: “Where is the print button or how do I make a mailing label?” We will be teaching you how to “do what you used to do” and not move you from a basic Word user to an advanced user.

### **Social Action . . .**

**Social Action Institute:** The annual Social Action Institute presented by the four dioceses of Iowa this January 18-19, was again a deeply enriching experience. Featured speakers, Antonio Cube of the US Conference of Catholic Bishops' Welcoming the Stranger program and the pastoral staff from St. Bridget's Parish in Postville, IA deeply involved attendees in the human side of immigration and the need for immigration reform. Other speakers addressed breakout sessions on respect for life, protecting God's creation, organizing for social change to combat poverty and the global food crisis. Sr. Jan Cebula of the Clinton Franciscan Sisters led a presentation on the need to work actively for peace in this critical point in history. Our thanks to the Diocese of Davenport parishes and their pastors who participated.

**Madagascar Update:** In 2004 the Diocese of Davenport entered into an agreement with Catholic Relief Services to form a Global Solidarity Partnership with the Diocese of Antsiranana in Madagascar. This offered us, the people of the Diocese of Davenport, an exciting opportunity to live Jesus' gospel message more fully. In this partnership, as in other partnerships, we share the many blessings we enjoy with each other as well as our needs and sorrows.

In 2005 a delegation of 12 people from various parts of the diocese visited the Diocese of Antsiranana. The following year our new friends from Madagascar came to be with us. Today we continue to enjoy the gifts of this partnership through the group known as Friends of Madagascar. **A visit to Madagascar is planned for June 2009 to further explore, study and expand this relationship.** The Friends of Madagascar, with our partners in the Diocese of Antsiranana, invite you to join us in the new and exciting adventure. **2008 Income Tax Help:** Low- and moderate income-working families may qualify for help from two federal tax benefits: Earned Income Credit (EIC) and the Child Tax Credit (CTC). This year eligible families can receive as much as \$4,824 from the EIC. If you know of families who may benefit please encourage them to file their taxes through the VITA program below.

**Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Program:** The VITA Program offers free tax help to low- to moderate-income (generally, \$42,000 and below) people who cannot prepare their own tax returns. Certified volunteers sponsored by various organizations receive training to help prepare basic tax returns in communities across the country. Most locations also offer free electronic filing. To locate the nearest VITA site, call 800-829-1040. Attached is a bilingual flyer listing the locations in Clinton, Davenport, DeWitt and Muscatine.

**Tax Counseling for the Elderly:** The Tax Counseling for the Elderly Program (TCE) provides free tax help to people aged 60 and older. Trained volunteers from non-profit organizations provide free tax counseling and basic income tax return preparation for senior citizens. Volunteers who provide tax counseling are often retired individuals associated with non-profit organizations that receive grants from the IRS.

### STEWARDSHIP OFFICE

**2009 Stewardship Institute:** It's time to recruit participants for the 2009 Stewardship Institute. This adult formation program is offered annually by the Diocese of Davenport, in conjunction with St. Ambrose University, to train and develop leaders for parish stewardship ministry.

Participants will deepen their understanding of stewardship by learning about the bishops' pastoral letter on stewardship. They will also explore possible strategies for developing stewardship ministry in their parish, by studying materials about the implementation of the stewardship pastoral.

The institute is now offered in several ways. Participants can be individuals who are the only person in their parish interested at this point, someone who wants to get stewardship going. Participants can also be a small group of people in one parish who are interested in going through the institute together. Or participants might be placed into a small group of people from a group of parishes in proximity to each other.

The institute includes two 8-week sessions, one that begins the week after Easter, the second beginning in August. Groups or individuals participating in the institute will receive a weekly email message during the institute reminding them of the schedule and assignments for that week.
