Reflection on Today's Readings

Jesus called the twelve and began to send them out two by two, and gave them authority over the unclean spirits. He ordered them to take nothing for their journey except a staff; no bread, no bag, no money; but to wear sandals and not to put on two tunics. So they went out and proclaimed that all should repent. They cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick and cured them.

We are all sent out by Jesus and invited to teach and to pray - each in his or her unique way. For the most part, we do this by our love for those we meet each day for this is what heals people more than anything else. It is the kind words we speak or the good deeds that we do, many times anonymously, that help us spread the Good News, often without even realizing it.
