UPDATE ON ADORATION CHAPEL

- The Chapel will be located in the current Meeting Room #4, which is past the Gathering Area kitchen, at the far end of the corridor.
- Adoration is expected to start by mid-December and is dependent on building permit application approval. Adoration is planned between the hours of 7:00 am and midnight, seven days a week, in one hour time slots. Currently, not enough parishioners have signed up to fill all the slots.
It is imperative that many more people sign up for adoration in order that all time slots are filled.
- During hours that the church is unlocked, approx. 7:00AM to 3:30PM, entry will be through the Gathering Area, turn left at the corridor and proceed to the end.
- During hours that the church is locked, entry will be through the single exterior door located on the south wall of the building just past the double entry doors for the Library. It will open directly into the Adoration Chapel. It can be accessed directly from the parking lot.
- This door currently cannot be opened from the outside. There is keyed lock on the door. The lock will be replaced with a new lock and a number of new keys will be cut. These keys will be distributed to all who sign up for Adoration. The names of those who have keys will be recorded. Obviously, adorers will have to safeguard these keys responsibly, so they do not lose them, nor that they end up with anyone who is not committed to adoration.
- After hours, when the church is locked, adorers will always have access to the corridor and washrooms opposite the Library, but not back into the Gathering Area. Exiting the building can be either through the single exterior door in the chapel or the double doors by the library.
- To create the new Chapel, a sound proof wall between meeting rooms #3 and #4 (the Adoration Chapel) will be constructed, to prevent the transmission of sound into the Adoration Chapel. This will be accomplished by removing the current sliding wall between meeting rooms #3 and #4, and building a permanent, acoustically insulated wall in its place. Some intrusion of sound from school children playing outside is inevitable.
- All the existing furniture in meeting room #4 will be removed.

- A new, small altar with a suitable tabernacle with a glass front (so the Blessed Sacrament is always visible to Adorers, but yet is secure and cannot be tampered with) will be located on the north wall of the room, with kneelers and seats suitably arranged to focus on the Blessed Sacrament. The monstrance will be similar to, but slightly smaller than the one that is currently used for adoration on Fridays in the church.
- There will be a ledger to record adoration activity, i.e. if time slots for adoration are being filled. Adorers will initial the ledger to indicate that they attended as scheduled.
- A building permit from the City of Delta is required for the necessary modifications and drawings have been prepared for submission to the City. Application will be made this week. We have been in discussions with contractors regarding the building of the new wall.
- A budget of \$25,000 has been estimated for this project, which includes the new wall, the modifications to the door, the new altar, tabernacle, monstrance, and building permit application fee. Benefactors have offered to cover the cost of the new wall and the monstrance, and we are carrying out fund raising for the remainder.
