Holy Thursday, April 18, 2019 *(no morning Masses)*

7:30PM *This liturgy stresses the importance that Jesus puts on the humility of service and the need for cleansing with water, a symbol of baptism. Also emphasized is the critical importance of the Eucharist and the sacrifice of Christ's body, which we now find present in the consecrated Host.*

Good Friday, April 19, 2019 *(no morning Masses)*

3:00PM *The Passion of our Lord.
This liturgy commemorates the passion, suffering, and death on the cross of Our Lord Jesus Christ.*

7:00PM Divine Mercy Novena & Chaplet

Easter Vigil, Saturday April 20, 2019 *(no morning Mass)*

12:00NOON Blessing of the Easter Food

8:30PM *This Holy Saturday liturgy is the final day of Holy Week, and also the conclusion of the traditional 40 day Lenten fast. A part of the Triduum, this liturgy commemorates Jesus lying in the tomb, until his resurrection on Easter Sunday.*
