LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Today instead of my letter, I am reprinting our Bishop's latest response to the scandals in new headlines these days, written to all of us as president of the Bishop's Conference. Cardinal DiNardo's full statement follows:

"In communion with the Holy Father, I join the Executive Committee of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) in taking up on ourselves his exhortation, 'this open wound [of abuse] challenges us to be firm and decisive in the pursuit of truth and justice.'

"On August 1st, I promised that USCCB would exercise the full extent of its authority, and would advocate before those with greater authority, to pursue the many questions surrounding Archbishop McCarrick. On August 16th, I called for an Apostolic Visitation, working in concert with a national lay commission granted independent authority, to seek the truth.

Yesterday, I convened our Executive Committee once again, and it reaffirmed the call for a prompt and thorough examination into how the grave moral failings of a brother bishop could have been tolerated for so long and proven no impediment to his advancement.

"The recent letter of Archbishop Carlo Maria Viganò brings particular focus and urgency to this examination. The questions raised deserve answers that are conclusive and based on evidence. Without those answers, innocent men may be tainted by false accusation and the guilty may be left to repeat sins of the past. "I am eager for an audience with the Holy Father to earn his support for our plan of action. That plan includes more detailed proposals to: seek out these answers, make reporting of abuse and misconduct by bishops easier, and improve procedures for resolving complaints against bishops.

Inspired by his recent letter to the people of God, and his motu proprio of two years ago, "As a Loving Mother", I am confident Pope Francis shares our desire for greater effectiveness and transparency in the matter of disciplining bishops. We renew our fraternal affection for the Holy Father in these difficult days.

"To the survivors of abuse and the families who have lost a loved one to abuse, I am sorry. You are no longer alone. Since 2002, hundreds of professionally trained staff across the country have been working with the Church to support survivors and prevent future abuse. Nationwide, the Church has a zero tolerance policy toward priests and deacons who abuse, safe-environment training, background checks for those working around children, victim assistance coordinators, prompt reporting to civil authorities, and lay review boards in dioceses.

"In other ways, we have failed you. This is especially true for adults being sexually harassed by those in positions of power, and for any abuse or harassment perpetrated by a bishop. We will do better. The more she is buffeted by storms, the more I am reminded that the Church's firm foundation is Jesus Christ. The failures of men cannot diminish the light of the gospel.

Lord by the help of your mercy, show us the way to salvation.

CARTA DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

Queridos Feligreses,

Hoy en vez de mi carta, estoy reimprimiendo la última repuesta de nuestro obispo a los escándalos encabezados estos días, escrita para todos nosotros como Presidente de la Conferencia Episcopal. La declaración completa del Cardenal DiNardo dice:

"en comunión con el Santo Padre, me uno al Comité Ejecutivo de la Conferencia estadounidense de obispos católicos (USCCB) en tomar sobre nosotros su exhortación," está herida abierta [de abusos] nos desafía a ser firmes y decisivos en la búsqueda de la verdad y la justicia.'

"El 1 de agosto, prometí que USCCB ejercería toda la extensión de su autoridad y abogamos ante aquellos con mayor autoridad, a las muchas preguntas que rodean al arzobispo McCarrick . El 16 de agosto, me llamaron para una visita apostólica, trabajo en conjunto con una Comisión Nacional laica, que concedió autoridad independiente, para buscar la verdad. Ayer convoqué a nuestro Comité Ejecutivo una vez más, y reiteró el llamado a una pronta exhaustiva y cuidadosa examinación en cómo los graves fallos morales de un hermano obispo han sido tolerados durante tanto tiempo y no poner ningún impedimento para su avance. "La reciente carta del arzobispo Carlo María Vegano pone especial énfasis y urgencia a este examen. Las preguntas merecen respuestas concluyentes y basadas en la evidencia. Sin esas respuestas, inocentes pueden ser contaminados por acusaciones falsas y el culpable puede quedarse para repetir los pecados del pasado.

"Estoy ansioso por una audiencia con el Santo Padre para pedir su apoyo para nuestro plan de acción. Dicho plan incluye propuestas más detalladas: para los que buscan estas respuestas, y hacer más fácil los reportes de abuso y mala conducta de los obispos y mejorar los procedimientos para resolver quejas en contra de obispos. Inspirado en su reciente carta al pueblo de Dios, y su modo propio de hace dos años, "Como una madre cariñosa", estoy seguro de que el Papa Francisco comparte nuestro deseo de una mayor y eficaz transparencia en materia de como disciplinar los obispos. Renovamos nuestro afecto fraternal por el Santo Padre en estos días difíciles. "A los supervivientes del abuso y las familias que han perdido un ser querido abusado, deberás lo lamento.

Ya no estás solo. Desde 2002, cientos de personal profesionalmente capacitado en todo el país han estado trabajando con la iglesia para apoyar a sobrevivientes y evitar abusos futuros. A nivel nacional, la iglesia tiene una política de cero tolerancia hacia los sacerdotes y diáconos que abusan, una caja de seguridad del ambiente de formación, con antecedentes de aquellos que trabajan alrededor de los niños, coordinadores de asistencia de víctimas, pronta información a las autoridades civiles y

laicos revisando el sistema de tableros en la Arquidiócesis.

"De que otra manera, le hemos fallado. Esto es especialmente ciertamente es para adultos sexualmente acosados por aquellos en posiciones de poder y para cualquier abuso o acoso perpetrado por algún obispo. Estoy seguro que lo haremos mejor. Por más que ella es azotada por tormentas, más me recuerda que la base firme de la iglesia es Jesucristo. Los fracasos de los hombres no pueden disminuir la luz del Evangelio.

Señor con la ayuda de tu misericordia, indícanos el camino a la salvación.

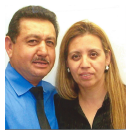
