Dear Parishioners, and Friends of St. Lawrence:

Thanks to all of you who have committed to the Diocesan “Fruitful Harvest” Fund Drive. This finances 50% of the operating costs of the diocese. Before this was implemented in the diocese in 1984 by Bishop Higi, diocesan funding relied on a parish tax. Depending on the expenses for the year, the Bishop would tax each parish a percent of its income. That tax varied from around 8% to 18%. It was never a favorite policy of the priests as the bill came at the end of the year.

If you haven't made a pledge, I would like to encourage you to do so – no, I want to beg you to do so. As it currently stands, we are \$57,000 short. If there is a shortfall, it must be made up by the parish from collection income – then we also lose 10% rebate when goal is reached. That would be another loss of \$13,000. Now you know why I am begging!

Monday, November 26, is a mandatory meeting of all the priests with the Bishop at which he will unroll his 5-10 year strategic plan for the whole diocese. How it will affect Muncie and our parishes will be known after that meeting. Pray for us and the diocese that the plan will serve the needs of the parishes of the diocese and be handled in the best way possible without chaos and serious difficulties. I am sure the plan will be presented to the entire diocese sometime after that meeting. The company directing this is Partner's Edge. No input has been sought from the priests – that I know of – so, I have no idea of what's in store. Prayer would be truly helpful as I have some anxiety about this. Whatever the outcome, I will deal with it the best way I know how – but please pray about it.

Again, it is Jesus, through the Holy Spirit, that keeps the Church alive – thank God!

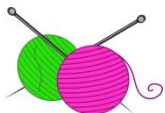

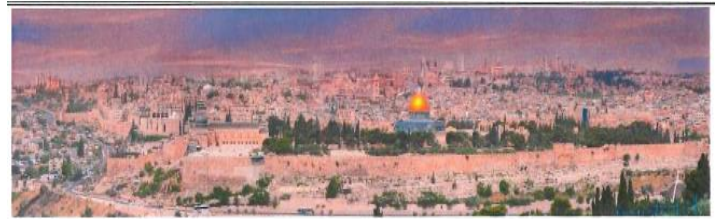
