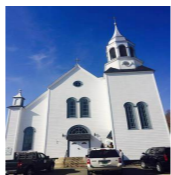

Join us for a wonderful meal and parish fellowship and share the excitement in their new space.

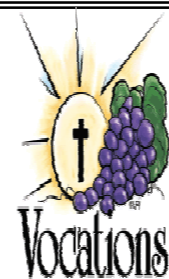

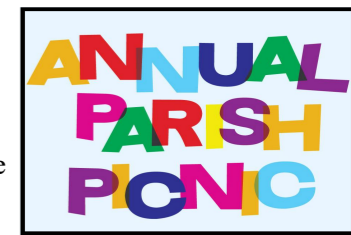
CHINESE AUCTION
