Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 90:12-17

The Responsorial Psalm reminds us that we cannot hope to please God without God first revealing to us what that means. We are fundamentally incapable of discerning God's will on our own. This is why we pray for wisdom.

We ask the Lord to send his Spirit into our hearts so that we might know his ways. We ask that same Spirit to give us the courage to do that which God has revealed to us.

We ask God to bless the work of our hands. This psalm reminds us that God is not only involved in things that we consider to be religious, but He is also present in every dimension of our lives.

No matter what occupation we have, we should ask God to bless our work. Otherwise, something will be missing.

We might even be accomplishing great things according to the standards of the world, but if God is not a part of it, it will have no heart or soul.
