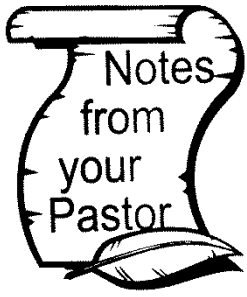

Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

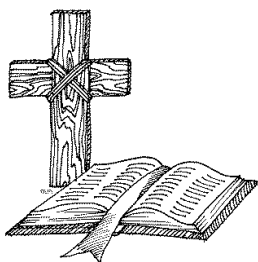
