



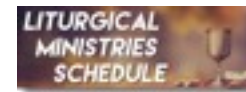

MARCH

Evangelization: That Christian communities, especially those who are persecuted, feel that they are close to Christ and have their rights respected.

Liturgy of the Word

The writer Sirach gives examples of how what is good is separated from what is poor, especially in speech. St. Paul reminds us that Christ has defeated death - it no longer has power over us. In the Gospel, Jesus uses the parable of the blind leading the blind to show there is a difference between what is good and what is evil. The first reading today uses the example of a sieve to show how grain (good fruit) is separated from the husks (the dead shell). Tribulation and difficulties are sieves in our own lives - and when we are shaken, the real fruit of who we are will be revealed in both our speech and actions.
