



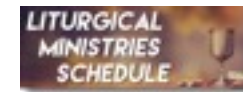

**Evangelization:** That Christian communities, especially those who are persecuted, feel that they are close to Christ and have their rights respected.

**Liturgy of the Word**  
In the Book of Deuteronomy, Moses instructs the people to offer gifts to the Lord for their freedom from slavery in Egypt, and for God's never-ending care. In his Letter to the Romans, Paul reminds his readers that without any distinction of nationality, all who call on the name of the Lord will be saved. Luke's Gospel tells how Jesus withstood the temptations of the devil.  
As we begin Lent, our penance and fasts seem rather small in comparison with how Jesus suffered for our salvation. Our forty days does not quite compare to His forty days in the desert. We need only to call on Jesus, and He will deliver us from our sins. Each Lent presents a new opportunity to repent and grow in our relationship with the One who gave His all so we could be His.

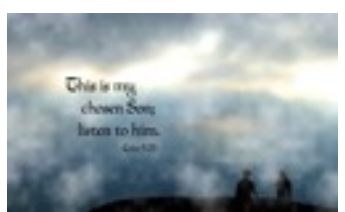

**Fasting and Abstinence**

<p><b>When do I ...?</b> Fast and Abstain: <b>Good Friday</b></p> <p><b>Abstain:</b> All Fridays during Lent</p> <p><b>Who has to ...?</b> Fast: Catholics who are 18 years of age, but not yet 59, are obliged</p> <p><b>Abstain:</b> observed by all Catholics 14 years-old and older</p>	<p><b>What is ...?</b> Fast: eating one full meal, as well as two small meals that together are not equal to a full meal</p> <p><b>Abstinence:</b> refrain from eating meat</p> <p><small>Note: Persons that are exempt from fasting include: the physically or mentally ill, individuals with chronic illness, and those pregnant or nursing.</small></p>
