March 4, 2018



**First Reading** - God gives the law through Moses (Exodus 20:1-17 [1-3, 7-8, 12-17]) or Exodus 17:3-7.

**Psalm** - Lord, you have the words of everlasting life (Psalm 19) or Psalm 95.

**Second Reading** - We proclaim Christ crucified (1 Corinthians 1:22-25) or Romans 5:1-2, 5-8.

## DIOCESEAN CATHOLIC SCHOOL SUBSIDY POLICY

To be considered as a subsidized student, the following must take place:

Families must be parishioners in good standing with one of the owner-parishes. A parishioner in good standing is defined as those who are;



- (1) Officially registered with their parish for at least one year.
- (2) Who worship regularly.
- (3) Who offer regular financial donations to their Parish by the use of Offering Envelopes.

All three criteria are used in determining eligibility of parish-subsidized tuition. The weekly church offering record is an indication of the family's presence at Mass and their monetary support. Of course, involvement in the church by way of ministry is also a valued consideration.

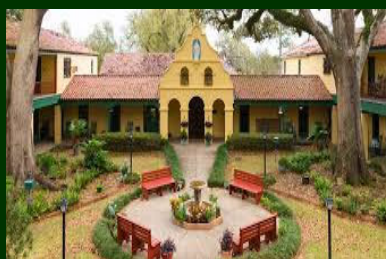
Parishioners requesting parish-subsidized tuition are asked to contribute at least \$600 per year, per child, in recorded funds to the church parish using Offertory Envelopes. The subsidy provided by the church parish to the school is well above this amount per child. Parish subsidized tuition is granted on a year to year basis following an annual review of each family's financial support record and church involvement.

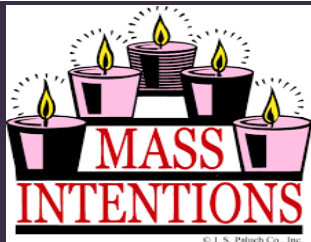
