SILVER AND GOLDEN WEDDING ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATION

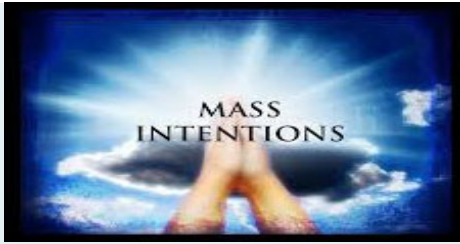

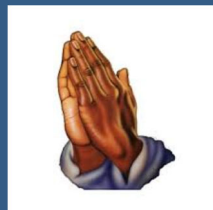
