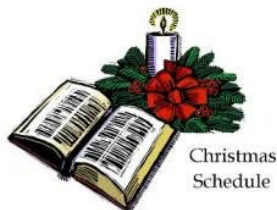

## ***OUR LADY OF PROMPT SUCCOR PARISH SECURITY AND SAFETY***

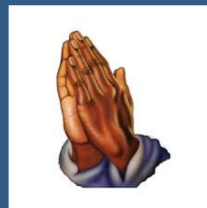
Please help by observing the following guidelines:

1. Arrive early for Mass.
2. Prior to beginning Mass, Ushers are asked to lock all exterior doors of the Church. Those who arrive after the doors have been locked may enter **only** through the central exterior doors at the main entrance, in the courtyard. An usher will open the door, exceptions will be made for those with special needs.
3. Anyone can leave the building at anytime, the lock does not block departure.
4. Always be aware of your surroundings, especially as you enter and exit the Church. Report suspicious behavior to an usher.
5. Please remain in the Church for the entirety of the Mass. If needed, go to the restroom before Mass. Pre-teenage children should be accompanied by a parent or guardian when use of the restroom cannot be delayed until after Mass.
6. Do not allow children to travel about inside or outside the building unsupervised at any time.
7. In cooperation with law enforcement officers, only certain individuals will be authorized to maintain safety and security during Mass.

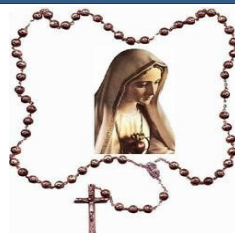
