I would like to share with you some positive things that have been taking place around the parish this past year. Our Buildings and Grounds Committee have been diligently completing a list of goals for the benefit of our parish. Among these are:

- New LED lighting installed in the parking lot as well as better electric capability to benefit our festival. More lighting on the school side is planned.
- New Trinity School interior wall to separate the nurse area from the copy room.
- Playground slides were repaired, new mulch put down and a border constructed.
- A sacristy exterior hand rail was constructed.
- A new rectory roof was installed.
- Soaker hoses were installed in church and rectory flower beds.
- LED replacement for church lighting is currently in progress.

Many of these projects were accomplished at no cost or for low cost due to the generosity of our brothers and sisters. Other major projects for the future will include a total re-vamping of our parking lot, traffic flow, fencing and grounds entities; and addressing the drainage issue on the church's flat roofs.

Many thanks to all who help on our parish committees whose "many hands make light work."
