The main dishes, sides, desserts & drink will be provided. Each family is asked to bring a dessert to share.

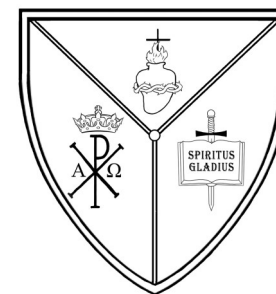

If you have not seen the media reports, Christopher Foxhoven, pastor of the churches in Glouster and Buchtel/Nelsonville, was charged with eight counts of sexual battery in Athens County Municipal Court on Tuesday for alleged sexual conduct with a 17-year-old minor, who was a member of his parish in Glouster.

We priests learned of this on Saturday evening, after Christopher went to the Bishop and told him on Saturday afternoon. As soon as the Bishop heard his testimony, a report was immediately filed with the Athens County Sheriff's Department at 3:15 PM on Saturday. I went out and celebrated the Sunday Mass and informed the parishioners of the news.

As you can imagine, last weekend, I wasn't sure how to pray. When faced with great difficulty, we often can be at a total loss for words. But the Spirit of God can express even our sighs and bewilderment to the heart of God. As St. Paul's letter to the Romans reminds us,

The Spirit comes to help us in our weakness. For when we cannot choose words in order to pray properly, the Spirit himself expresses our plea in a way that could never be put into words, and God who knows everything in our hearts knows perfectly well what he means, and that the pleas of the saints expressed by the Spirit are according to the mind of God. (Rom 8:26-27)

I continue to raise this to God, even when I don't have words. This whole "summer of shame," this terrible local news, abuse in general and violence breaks my heart. Please raise this to God with me.

Because our Diocese does not have extra priests to send to the parishes right now, we are approaching this as a team ministerial effort. Fr. Pat Gaughan and Fr. Don Horak will be taking care of the spiritual needs of the parishes in Buchtel and Glouster, while I will be taking care of the temporal and administrative needs. The parishes have an administrative professional who keeps things running efficiently, so she is a great blessing! Fr. Don will be the official "Interim Administrator" as required by Canon Law, so please pray for him as he has been called back into official duties.

May God give us strength!
