

## **St. Mary's Church, Remsen, Ia., contains 104 images of angels:**

### **3 in the art glass windows:**

- 1 (Archangel Raphael) in the Tobit window, north wall near back of church
- 2 in the Crowning of Mary window, south transept, left of the old confessional

### **46 in the pillar capitals**

- 4 on each pillar capital in the nave (10 pillars)
- 3 on each pillar capital in the sanctuary (2 pillars)

### **2 in the base relief panels on each side altar**

- 1 on the Mary altar frontal
- 1 on the Joseph altar frontal

### **4 in the sanctuary lamp that hangs above the Altar of Sacrifice**

### **6 in the restored paintings**

- 3 in the Resurrection painting (two are in the clouds)
- 3 in the Assumption painting

### **43 in the high altar**

- 1 on the "Abraham and Isaac" base relief, right side of the altar base frontal
- 2 under Sts. Peter and Paul statues
- 12 in the upper tabernacle arch
- 6 in the center tabernacle arch
- 10 on the lower tabernacle arch
- 8 statues
- 2 full figure carvings
- 2 on the Eucharistic Adoration monstrance (normally hidden from view)

### **Other facts:**

- 43 total angels in the nave (area people sit in)
- 61 total angels in the sanctuary (area with the altars and podium)
- 43 total angels on the high altar.
- 2 angels are known missing; used to stand on the pedestals just under the crucifix on high altar
