Saint John Vianney Parish will be holding a Forty Hours Devotion on Monday, June 1, Thursday, June 4, Friday, June 5, and Saturday, June 6, in preparation for the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the annual celebration of the Catholic Church in thanksgiving for the gift of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

This devotion developed in the 16th century in Italy and offers the opportunity to spend time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament for the Church and the world. The forty hours represent the time Christ's body spent in the tomb. STATIONS OF THE CROSS


