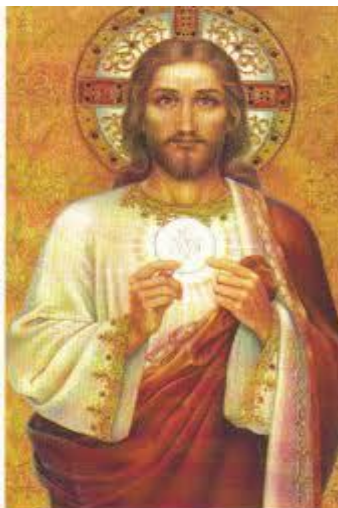

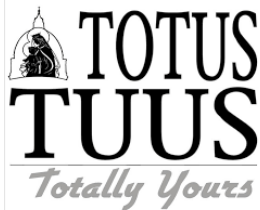

PARISH REGISTRATION

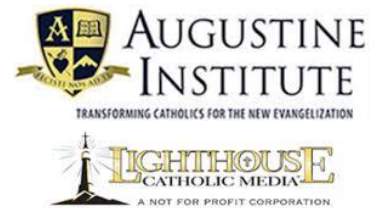
If you are new to our parish or have lived in the area and attend Mass but have never registered, we invite you to become an official member of St. John Vianney Church.
