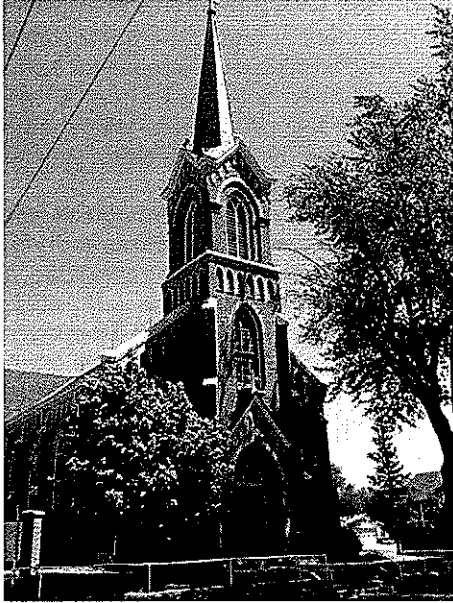


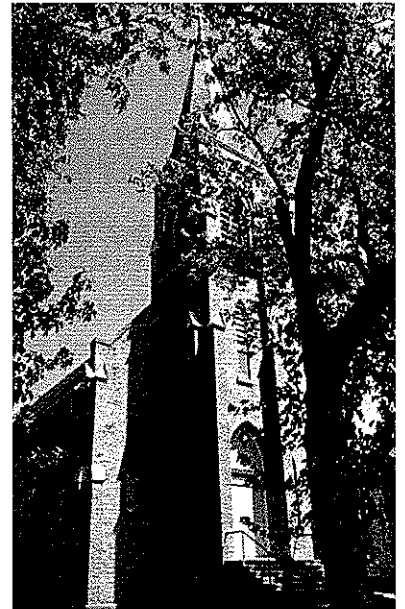

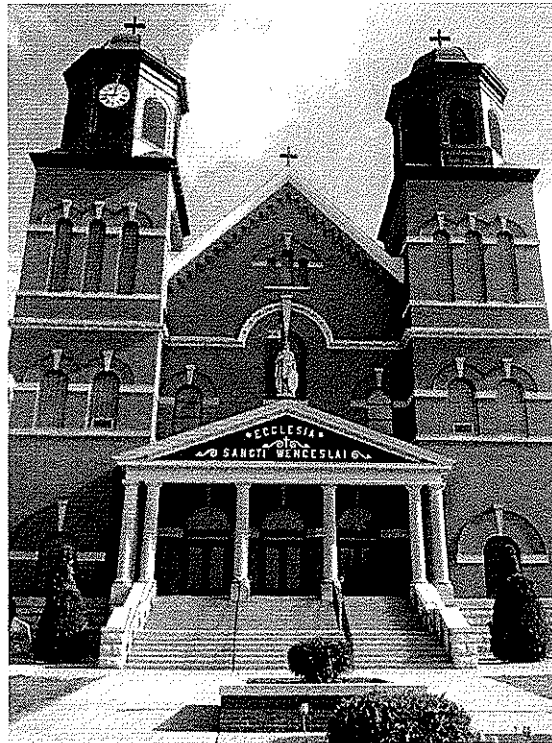

**Liturgical Ministry Opportunities**

All parishioners are invited to become involved in the liturgical life of St. Wenceslaus Church. With the new school year fast approaching, now is a good time to consider how you might enrich your participation. Please consider...

**Eucharistic Ministry**

Eucharistic ministers are men, women, and confirmed youth who are trained, commissioned, and entrusted with the duty of distributing the Holy Eucharist to fellow parishioners at Mass, the homebound, or those in the hospital. Eucharistic ministry to people in senior residences is offered each Sun. In addition, a Tues. & Thurs. prayer service or Mass is offered at Mala Strana each week. Homebound residents are offered Word & Communion by appointment.

**Gift Bearers**

Parishioners represent the faith community by presenting the gifts of water, wine, and bread to the priest during Mass. You and your family are invited to sign up in the back of church.

**Ushers**

The ministry of ushers is one of hospitality. Ushers arrive 20 minutes before Mass to welcome people, assist in seating, and gather the collection. They also direct the communion lines, distribute bulletins after Mass, and assist with emergency situations.

**Greeters**

Like ushers, greeters are a ministry of hospitality. All you need is a friendly smile to welcome members as they gather for weekend liturgies. Arrive 20 minutes before Mass to greet fellow parishioners.

**Sacristans**

Sacristans serve the liturgical assembly by preparing the items and people needed by the presider to properly and prayerfully celebrate Mass and other liturgies in a smooth and flowing manner. Sacristans serve at the weekday or weekend Mass of their choice.

**Lectors**

The lector proclaims God's Word with those assembled for Mass. Training is provided and lectors prepare at home using the lector workbook to proclaim the Word in a manner that can be heard clearly by the assembly. Lectors arrive 15 minutes before Mass begins.

**Word & Communion Lay Presiders**

Parishioners are trained to preside at Word & Communion services on the days when there is not a daily Mass. They receive resources to help with a reflection on the readings of the day.

**Daily Lectors & Rosary**

Lead rosary before daily Mass or Word & Communion service or proclaim the Word at daily Mass or Word & Communion service.

**Worship & Environment Committee**

This committee helps the church community celebrate the changing liturgical seasons by using flowers and plants, color, and symbols. Creating an inviting and prayerful atmosphere through the use of these visual aids is the goal of our ministry. The group also assists in implementing meaningful liturgical celebrations, especially during Advent and Holy Week.

**Prayer Cells**

People are invited M, T, W to the chapel for an hour of prayer following morning Mass or Word & Communion service. The rosary-based prayers are from the World Apostolate of Fatima and are offered in a spirit of reparation and conversion.

**Eucharistic Adoration**

Adoration is a quiet time spent in prayer or meditation before Jesus, present in the Blessed Sacrament. This devotion is held in the chapel in the PAC every Friday from 9 am to midnight. All are welcome to stop in any time for as long as they like, but two people are needed to be present at the chapel each hour Adoration is open.

## From the Desk of Father Dave

### Call On Your Mother

This past week was the feast of the Assumption of Mary's body and soul into Heaven. She did not know the decay and destruction of death. She went immediately into the light of her son. The mother of Jesus took her rightful place in order to pray for all and to lead us constantly to her son. She is the sacred vessel of our Lord. We can place our petitions with her and they can bear fruit in the world as we are brought into the master plan of salvation won for us on the cross.

Speaking of mothers, St. Monica is remembered on August 27th. We will remember her and ask for her intercession. She is a patroness of those who pray for conversion into the Catholic faith. She prayed for years for her son, St Augustine, to come into the faith. He turned out to be an incredible saint and his feast day is August 28th, the day after Monica's. Let us be like Monica and pray for conversion.

We pray for conversion of those outside the Church and for those who already call themselves Catholic who need to have a deeper relationship with Jesus. I have three approaches to prayer from my homily that can work. 1) A prayer caravan where we would drive as many cars as we could to pray at each of our three sites. We might even go to the former St. Joseph and St. Benedict church sites as well. This way we would physically pray for the whole parish. 2) Simultaneously pray the same prayer at all three worship sites. This would be a great sign of unity and could really bring strength to our community. 3) Eucharistic Adoration from 5:30 to 9:30 on either Tuesday or Thursday evening. This would call for a minimum of eight adorers per evening (2 people X 4 hours). I would like a coordinator for this to schedule the adorers, but I would physically take care of the space. I want to hear what you think of these ideas and if you would like to help bring them to reality.

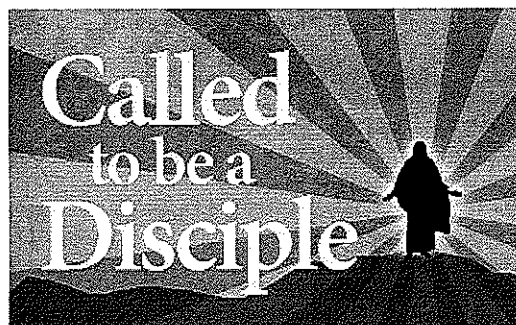
## PARISH AND AREA NEWS

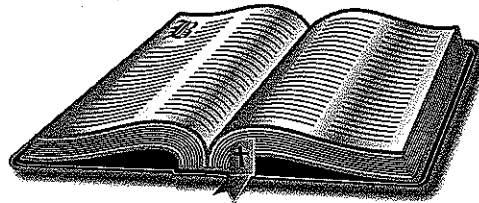

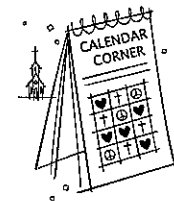
