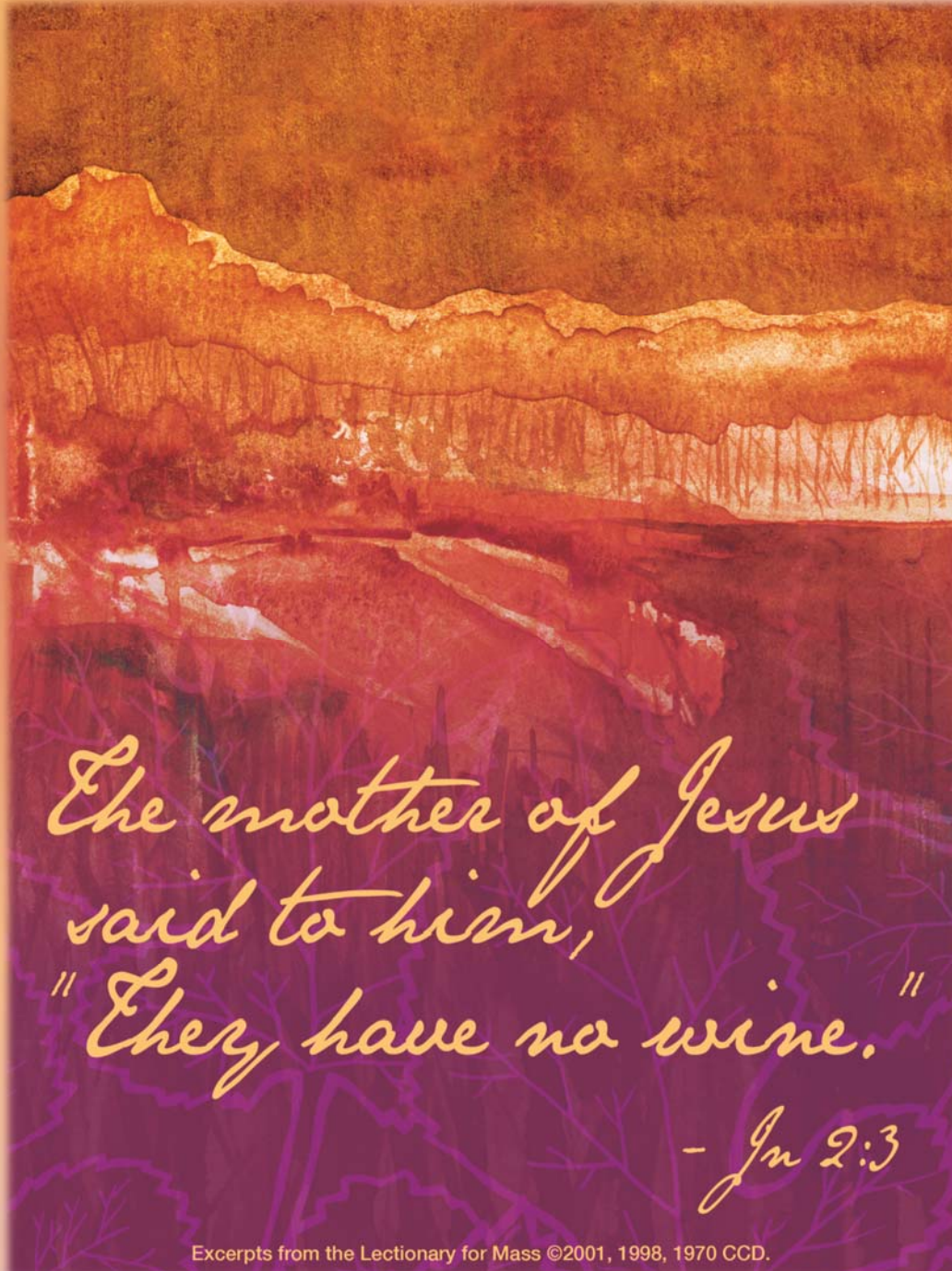

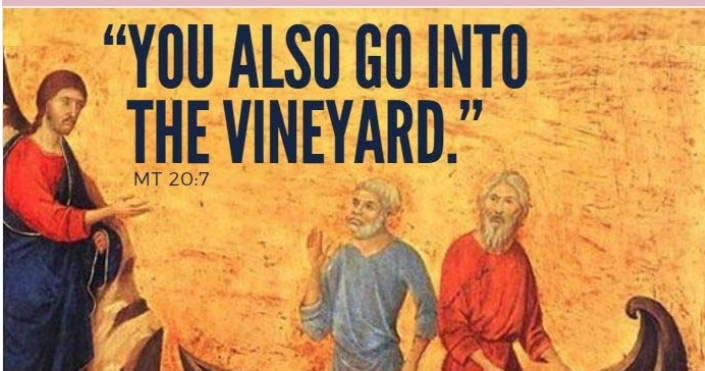
**BEATITUDES FOR FRIENDS OF THE AGED**

bags in the bins.

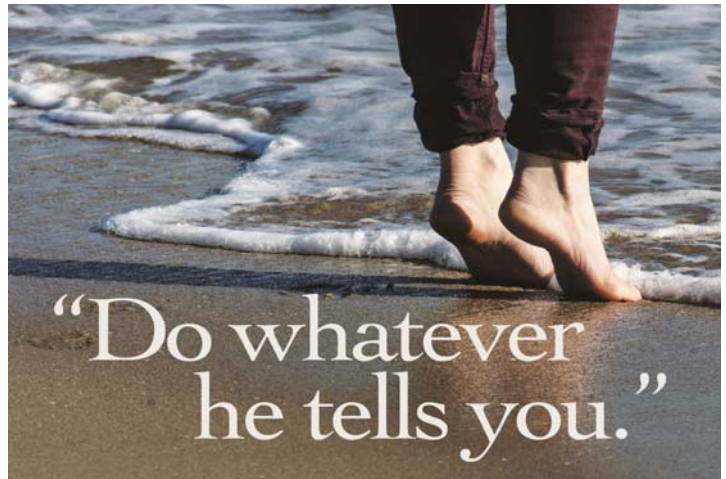

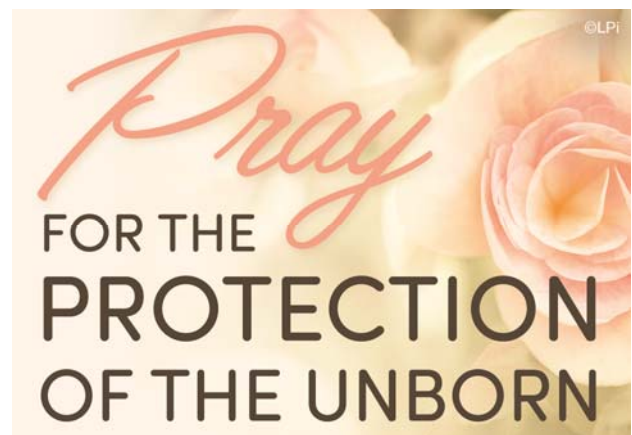

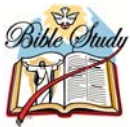

COME HOME . . . WE MISS YOU.

People drift away from the Church for many reasons. They may have been harmed by the hurtful remarks or actions of others in the Church.

One of the most common reasons Catholics become alienated from the Church involves church policies related to divorce or remarriage.

Some Catholics still believe divorce in itself means a person is either excommunicated or may not receive the Sacraments. So, once divorced, they stay away from the Church. Those who want to remarry sometimes don't understand the Church's annulment process. Some slip away because of apathy or because they have been offended by scandal in the Church. Others have turned away because they think they have committed a sin too great to be forgiven. Whatever the reason you may have drifted away from the Church, we ask you to consider coming back home. Please take this opportunity to simply speak to people who may be helpful in answering your questions about marriage or other issues pertaining to reconciliation with the Church.

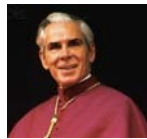

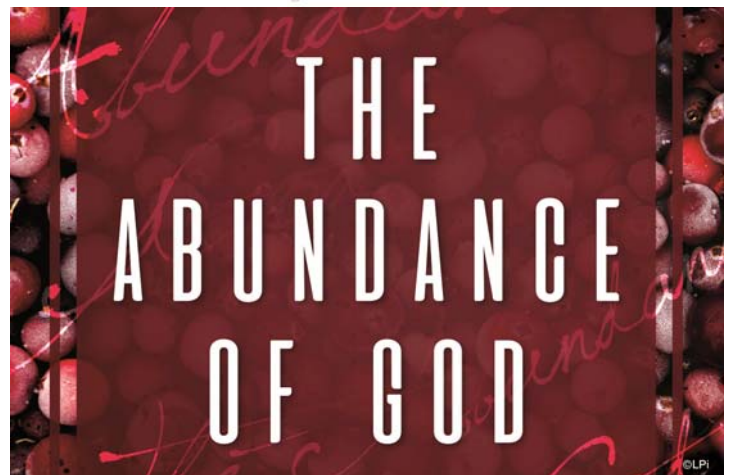
