**El Santo Evangelio según San Lucas (Lc 6: 17, 20-26)**

En aquel tiempo, Jesús descendió del monte con sus discípulos y sus apóstoles y se detuvo en un llano. Allí se encontraba mucha gente, que había venido tanto de Judea y de Jerusalén, como de la costa de Tiro y de Sidón. Mirando entonces a sus discípulos, Jesús les dijo:

"Dichosos ustedes los pobres, porque de ustedes es el Reino de Dios.

Dichosos ustedes los que ahora tienen hambre, porque serán saciados.

Dichosos ustedes los que lloran ahora, porque al fin reirán.

Dichosos serán ustedes cuando los hombres los aborrezcan y los expulsen de entre ellos, y cuando los insulten y maldigan por causa del Hijo del hombre. Alégrese ese día y salten de gozo, porque su recompensa será grande en el cielo. Pues así trataron sus padres a los profetas.

Pero ¡ay de ustedes, los ricos, porque ya tienen ahora su consuelo!

¡Ay de ustedes, los que se hartan ahora, porque después tendrán hambre!

¡Ay de ustedes, los que ríen ahora, porque llorarán de pena!

¡Ay de ustedes, cuando todo el mundo los alabe, porque de ese modo trataron sus padres a los falsos profetas!" **Palabra de Dios.**

**Reflexión**

La liturgia de este domingo nos narra el célebre discurso que aún hoy, a muchos parece incomprensible e inaceptable: el llamado Sermón de las Bienaventuranzas, refiriéndose a la dicha y la gloria con la que Dios-Padre gratificará a todos aquellos que, confiando en la sabiduría misericordiosa, volvemos a vivir las bienaventuranzas y misericordia infinita de Dios soportando los sufrimientos y carencias, las limitaciones y discriminaciones, los atropellos morales y físicos, que solo alimentando las fuerzas en las promesas de Aquél que es infinitamente justo, se podrán soportar.

Dios sabrá recompensar con creces cualquier sufrimiento que sea ofrecido en el Santo Nombre de Jesús. Esto se conoce como "Ley de Compensación", basada en la certeza de que Dios, en la misma creación del mundo, "Vio que todo era bueno". Todo fue pensado bueno para el disfrute de la criatura más amada por Él que somos **todos los seres humanos sin distinción** pero que, producto del pecado, se hicieron esclavos del placer y el consumismo y con el mal uso de su libertad, cegados por el egoísmo y el odio a sus semejantes, perdieron e hicieron perder en el mundo todo lo bueno que Dios había creado para su disfrute. Es de aquí que Dios sabrá recompensar, al salir de este mundo, a las víctimas que sufren a causa de aquellos que por las consecuencias del pecado, hacen daño; todos aquellos que han abusado de los más débiles, usurpándoles la paz, sus bienes y hasta la propia vida por el egoísmo (fruto del pecado). Estos también tendrán su recompensa, pero muy diferente a las de sus víctimas. Por eso Jesús les dice: "Ay de ustedes"; de aquí las llamadas **malaventuranzas**. Aquí está la diferencia: "Bienaventurados ustedes...", si ahora sufren en mi nombre; y "Ay de ustedes...", si ahora ríen.

Cuando vemos en las noticias lo que pasa en el mundo, entendemos que la fidelidad a Cristo y a su Evangelio hace que los cristianos seamos rechazados, escarnecidos en los medios de comunicación, odiados, como Cristo fue odiado y colgado en la cruz. A pesar de todo, Jesús nos infunde coraje al decirnos hoy: "Bienaventurados serán cuando los hombres los odien, cuando los expulsen, los injurien y proscriban sus nombres como malo, por causa del Hijo del hombre... porque su recompensa será grande en el cielo". Así nos muestra otro camino que es la felicidad del Reino de Dios, cuestión que para entenderlo, tenemos la experiencia cristiana de los santos, quienes nos muestran que el camino es el amor que Cristo nos ha mostrado desde la Cruz. **¡Paz y bien! Padre Rodolfo**



***The Holy Gospel According to St Luke (LK 6: 17, 20-26)***

Jesus came down with the twelve and stood on a stretch of level ground with a great crowd of his disciples and a large number of the people from all Judea and Jerusalem and the coastal region of Tyre and Sidon. And raising his eyes toward his disciples he said:

“Blessed are you who are poor, for the kingdom of God is yours.  
 Blessed are you who are now hungry, for you will be satisfied.  
 Blessed are you who are now weeping, for you will laugh.

Blessed are you when people hate you, and when they exclude and insult you, and denounce your name as evil on account of the Son of Man. Rejoice and leap for joy on that day! Behold, your reward will be great in heaven. For their ancestors treated the prophets in the same way.

But woe to you who are rich, for you have received your consolation.  
 Woe to you who are filled now, for you will be hungry.  
 Woe to you who laugh now, for you will grieve and weep.  
 Woe to you when all speak well of you, for their ancestors treated the false prophets in this way.”

***Reflection***

This Sunday’s Liturgy tells us the famous discourse that even today to many seems incomprehensible and unacceptable: the Beatitudes, also known as the Sermon on the Mount, referring to the joy and glory with which the Father will reward all those who, trusting in His merciful wisdom, live the beatitudes and infinite mercy of God by enduring sufferings and shortcomings, limitations and discriminations, moral and physical outrages, because only by counting on the nourishment found in the promises of Him who is infinitely just will we be able to endure.

God will fully reward any suffering that is offered in the Holy Name of Jesus. This is known as the "Law of Compensation," based on the certainty that God, in the very creation of the world, "saw that everything was good." Everything was thought good for the enjoyment of the creature most loved by Him: "All human beings without distinction," but who, as a result of sin, became slaves of pleasure and consumerism and with the misuse of their freedom, blinded by selfishness and hatred of their fellow men, lost the good that God had created for their enjoyment. It is from here that God will know how to reward, when leaving this world, the victims who suffer because of those who, because of the consequences of sin, do harm; all those who have abused the weakest, usurping them peace, their goods and even their own lives for selfishness (fruit of sin). These will also have their reward, but very different from those of their victims. That is why Jesus says to them: "Woe to you"; hence the so-called "Seven Woes". Here is the difference: "Blessed are you ...", if you suffer now in my name; and "Woe to you ...", if they laugh now.

When we see in the news what is happening in the world, we understand that fidelity to Christ and to his Gospel causes Christians to be rejected, mocked in the media, hated, as Christ was hated and hung on the cross. In spite of everything, Jesus inspires us with courage by telling us today: "Blessed are they when men hate them, when they drive them out, insult them, and proscribe their names as evil, because of the Son of man ... because their reward will be great in heaven". This shows us another path that is the happiness of the Kingdom of God, an issue that to understand, we have the Christian experience of the saints, who show us that the way is the love that Christ has shown us from the Cross. ¡Paz y Bien! ***Fray Rodolfo***

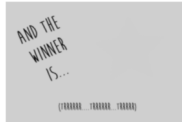
