Stories of Two Women

Jesus raises both to life – New life. At the heart of raising these women to life and restoring their humanity is the humane compassion of Jesus. "Daughter, your faith has saved you, Go in peace and be cured of your affliction".

Today's Gospel tells us about the divine power and infinite mercy of Jesus. Apart from proving his claim to be the promised Messiah, all his miracles had as their aim and their end to remove the pain and sufferings of human persons. He did not perform any miracle for the sake of astonishing people or to satisfy idle curiosity of people. Each one was performed to help someone in distress. All who were helped by his miracle of mercy had one thing in common, namely, they were motivated by faith in him and trusted fully in his mercy and power.
