**Fr. Tony Birdsall Prayer & Reflection Garden**

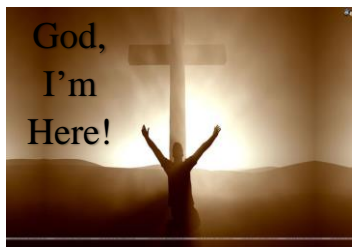
