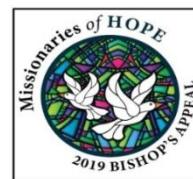

Mass Intentions

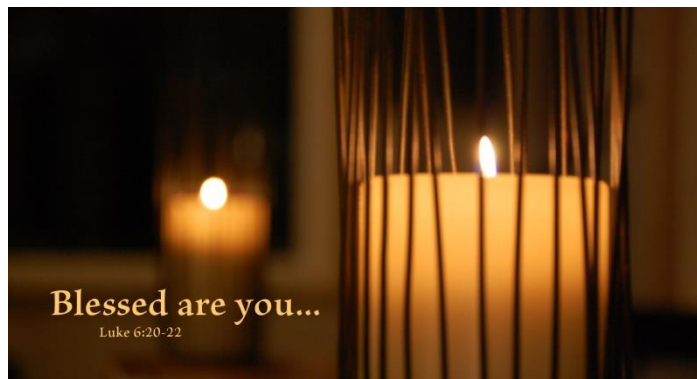
Contact the parish office to do a mass intention. Stipend per Mass is \$10.00.
