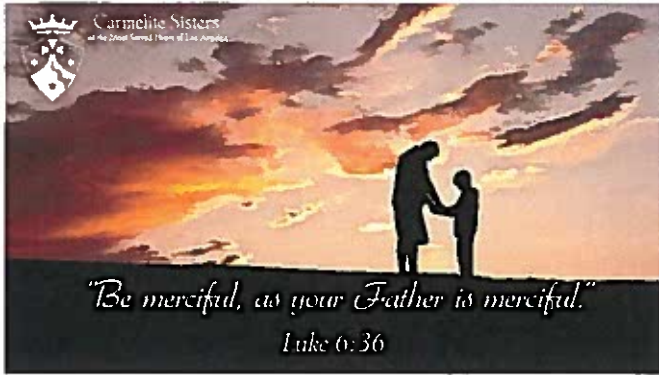

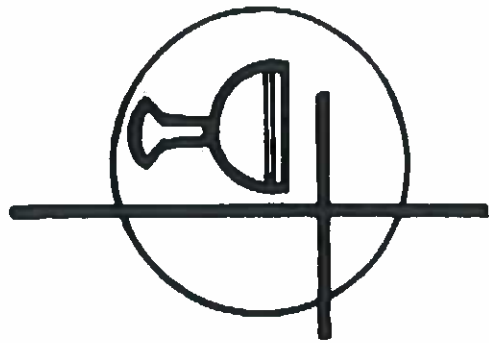
Find Your Greatness

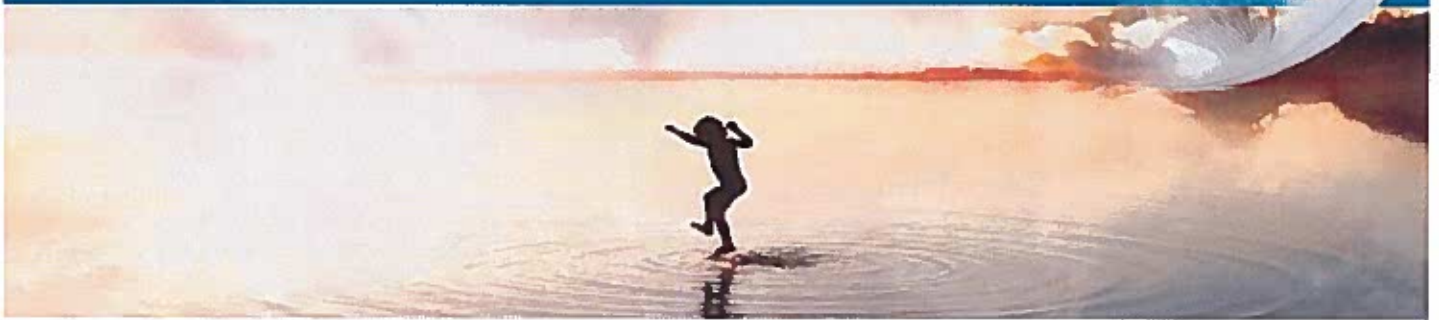
