2019 OLV SPRING SPORTS REGISTRATION NOW OPEN!

2019 OLV Spring Sports Registration is now open **through March 1**, for students interested in playing CYO **Baseball** (boys/grade 5-8), CYO **Lacrosse** (boys/grade 5-8) or CYO Softball (girls/grade 5-8).

PLEASE NOTE: that without enough participation, **teams will NOT be formed!** We still need a few more 5/6 grade girls to complete a softball team. This is a great age to try out a new sport!

- **UPDATED PLAYER PARTICIPATION RULING:** Beginning in 2018, CYO will once again allow players in baseball and softball to participate in the same sport in any other organized league with the exception of playing on a Junior High School, Middle School or Elementary School team.
- **To Register:** Please visit www.OLVAthletics.com to register and click on PLAYER/COACH REGISTRATION on the horizontal tabs. Follow the provided instructions and include payment to OLV Dads' Club at the end via secure PayPal account (sorry, checks are not accepted).
- **Season Length:** From March 11-May 12-Varsity playoffs through May 16. Generally, practices are 2-3 times a week plus games on weekends. Please keep this in mind if your child also plays travel/club sports. CYO League games cannot be scheduled around travel/club team schedules
- **Forms and Fees:** A student must submit or have previously submitted a current health status/physical, dated after April 15, 2018, to be considered for a team. Registration fees are to be paid online through the OLV Athletic's site and must be paid in full prior to a player participating in a practice.
- **Coaching Applications:** Will be accepted until February 28, by visiting www.OLVAthletics.com. Whether you can volunteer your time as a Head Coach or Assistant Coach, please know that our program could not be successful without you.
