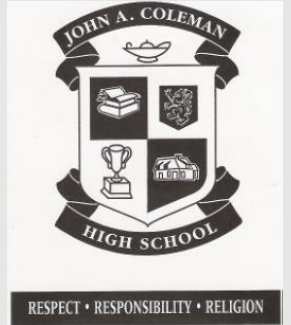


Golden Wedding Jubilee Mass
