Periodically, a young man who is more involved in the youth leadership of PBMR will ask about finances. We are not like a lot of places that they know that require a fee to be paid. I speak to them about people who we know or who we have met along the way who just want to be of support. I tell them that they share what they have with us. I can tell that they don't really understand that...it is not a part of their experience.

But the truth is that they are becoming more aware of the need to be generous—with their time or just by helping Fr. More and more the youth ask, "Can I help?"
