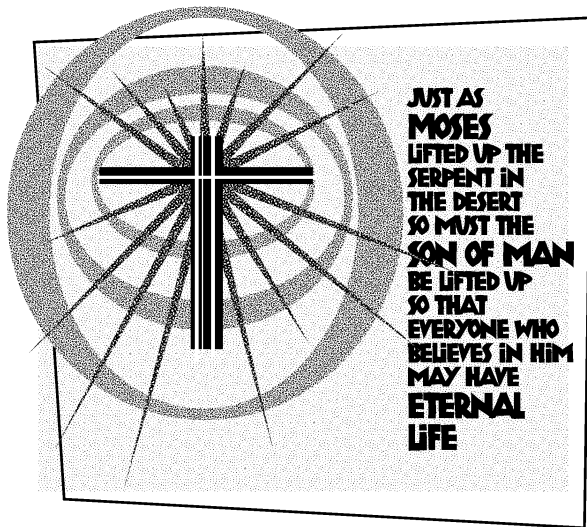


Fourth Sunday of Lent

Reflection on the Scriptures

While Jesus healed the blind man - many were too blind to accept this miracle which had come from God. How often do we sometimes miss the grace that is present in our own lives, miss the many "small miracles" that happen day by day because we are too busy noticing the negative or what we consider missing in our lives? In doing this, we miss God's amazing grace. What we focus on, we give power to. Many in the Gospel story focused on their belief in the sinfulness of the blind man and missed the amazing grace that God can heal - God can transform - God is so good. They missed the value of this person who was a child of God. How often do we ignore and are blinded to those in our own society who have been outcasts: the homeless, those suffering with HIV/AIDS, victims of domestic violence, the elderly; who like the blind man are in need of God's healing and loving touch. How can we be that healing touch for others? As we continue on this journey during Lent, how can we change our focus? In what ways do we need to ask God to increase our sight, remove our blindness, so that we can respond in a way that brings God's light and goodness to others in our communities and in our world?
