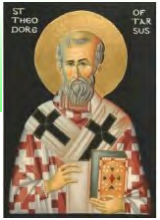

Mission Appeal By "Hands Together"



The Diocese of Crookston has designed a missionary cooperative plan that invites a mission group to every parish to speak about the work of the Church in other parts of the world. This weekend our parishes are assigned "Hands Together" – a Catholic mission outreach organization that works in Haiti, to share with us how our church continues to help the poorest of the poor.

Church in Haiti is struggling to bring God's love to the many hurting people. In Haiti there are 10.9 million people in an area smaller than Maryland. 70% of these cannot read, and 85% live below poverty level. In slum areas 4 out of 5 children do not reach the age of five, and nationally 1 in 3 children suffer from chronic malnutrition.

"Hands Together" runs free schools, medical clinics and nutrition programs in Cite Soleil, providing 25,000 daily school meals and helping thousands of people who struggle to survive. Their work among the poor is founded upon the Catholic social teachings of the dignity of human life and a preferential option for the poor. About one-third of "Hands Together" mission work supports educational, health, charity and developmental projects in City Soleil in the Diocese of Gonaives and Cap Haitian.

Please welcome Fr. Jack Martin this weekend, who is a faithful volunteer for "Hands Together". He has been to Haiti many times and visits parishes around the USA to share his experience working with Catholic missionaries there. Welcome Fr. Martin!
